

# Expression of Interest

## FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PAKISTAN PAVILIONS IN INTERNATIONAL TRADE FAIRS

Trade Development Authority of Pakistan (TDAP), premier export promotion organization of the country regularly organizes the Pakistan pavilion for collective participation of Pakistani exhibitors in major international trade fairs and exhibitions across the world to promote exports of Pakistani products. The major destinations of Pakistan Pavilions are Europe, Asia, Middle East, Far East, Americas and Africa. The major product categories displayed in these exhibitions are Textiles, Leather and its products, Sports Goods, Surgical Instruments, Carpets, Agri-Food, Engineering Goods, Pharmaceutical, Stationery, Gems & Jewellery, Footwear, Services, Furniture & handicrafts etc.

TDAP requires the services of a professional stand construction company with previous experience in handling work of similar nature at international fairs and exhibitions, for conceptualization, designing, construction and decoration of the Pakistan Pavilions and other related ancillary activities for official participation of Pakistani exhibitors in the trade fairs to be held around the world from January 2012 to June 2013. The interested companies should be financially sound and have the administrative and technical ability coupled with relevant experience to comprehend the project.

Detailed scope of work and bidding documents can be obtained on any working day between 10:00 am-04:00 pm from the office of the undersigned on payment of Rs.2000/- in the form of pay order/Bank draft in favor of Accounts Officer, TDAP. The tentative list of trade fairs selected for participation from January 2012 to June 2013 can also be obtained. The list is only indicative and the TDAP reserves the right to add new fairs in this list or delete the fairs already mentioned therein.

4. Quality and efficiency are critical to ensure smooth operation of stand at International Exhibitions. All interested firms/companies meeting the necessary criteria are requested to submit their proposals in line with the instructions given in the bidding documents by 11:30 am on 9th January 2012. The submitted proposals will be opened in the presence of representatives of participating firms on the same day at about 12:30pm.

5. Contract will be awarded to bidder whose bid will be technically qualified, financially lowest and deemed best for the purpose.

6. PPRA rules will be fully applied. In line with PPRA rules, TDAP reserves the right to accept / reject any proposal. However, the reason(s) for the rejection of proposal(s) will be communicated to ensure the transparency.
