<u>Criteria for issuance of Visa Recommendation Letter to the Exporters</u>

Trade Facilitation Division of TDAP issues visa recommendation letters to individual traders (not to delegations or exhibition participants). The visa recommendations can be issued by submitting the following documents:

DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Request letter to TDAP.
- 2) Undertaking on Stamp paper (Rs.100/-) Mandatory.
- 3) Application on letter head through respective Trade Association / Chamber
- 4) Company Profile.
- 5) Original Export Performance of last three years duly verified by Bank (for Regular Exporters).
- Bank Statement for last three years (for New Exporters / SMEs / Women Entrepreneurs).
- 7) Copy of valid Membership Certificate of Trade Body / Chamber / Association.
- 8) Photocopy of NTN / Sales Tax Registration.
- 9) Copies of valid Passport(s) & CNIC(s) of the person(s) representing the Company.
- 10) Copies of internationally recognized Quality Certificates (e.g. ISO, GAP), if acquired.
- 11) Schedule of Visits/Meetings with clients (Email correspondence, if any), or event schedule (if any).
