

“EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR MEDICAL CONSULTANT ”

Trade Development Authority of Pakistan (TDAP) seeks services of Medical Practitioner/ Medical Consultant/ Firm on retainer-ship basis.

2. The Trade Development Authority of Pakistan (TDAP) has sixteen (16) offices operating all over Pakistan, and around 800 employees. As per TDAP’s Service and Federal Government Rules, the employees, pensioners and their families are entitled to get reimbursement of their medical expenditures.

3. The interested Firm/Practitioner/Consultant will submit their proposals in response to this Expression of Interest. In terms of selecting the Medical Consultant, “Quality Based Selection” as per PPRA’s Procurement of Consultancy Services 2010 (3A-ii-c) will be adopted by TDAP. All interested applicants/firms should have minimum qualification of M.B.B.S along with valid registration from PMDC. The applicants/ firms should have at least 5 years’ experience of medical practice. Evaluation of the submitted proposals shall be carried out in two stages in following manner, namely:-

- i.) The technical proposal shall be evaluated and TDAP may discuss technical details, if it may deem necessary;
- ii.) The financial proposal of technically responsive proposals shall be opened in the presence of the applicants or their representatives who may wish to attend the opening session; and
- iii.) A combined evaluation of technical and financial (60:40) proposals shall follow and the applicant with the winning proposal will be accepted.

4. The EoI document may be obtained from the office of the undersigned at below given address or downloaded from www.tdap.gov.pk. Sealed proposals (technical and financial in separate envelopes) shall be submitted latest by 11:00 a.m. on 25-10-2019 at the address given below. Technical proposals submitted will be opened on the same day at 12:00 Noon in the presence of representatives of the participating firms.

5. TDAP reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to annul the bidding process at any time, however, reasons for rejection or annulling bid process will be communicated to the concerned bidder (s) in accordance with PPRA rules.
