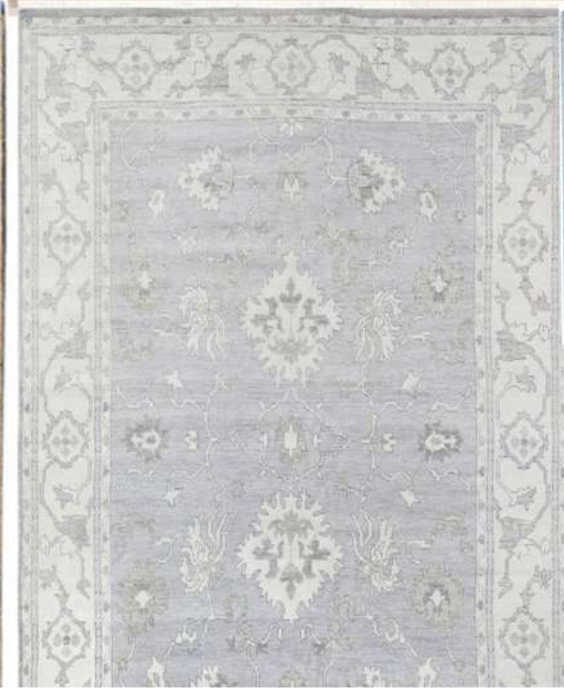

There are two types of carpet making i.e. machine made and handmade/hand-knotted. Unique designs, durability and natural materials make hand woven carpets superior in quality than machine made carpets. Pakistani hand-knotted carpets are known as one of the finest carpets in the world and due to their top notch quality, attention to details and strength, they are in large demand worldwide. Production of hand-knotted carpets is one of the largest cottage industries of Pakistan. Although mass-produced, these Pakistani hand knotted carpets are traditionally made by the hands of professional weavers who have thrived in this industry for generations.

Khan, Shangla Hills, Gujranwala, Attock, Ahmed Pur East Bahawalpur, Zahir Peer, and surrounding areas of Quetta, Peshawar and Lahore where skilled workers are easily available.



LOCAL CONSUMPTION:

Pakistani carpets are in huge demand in the world due to their quality and beautiful designs. According to Pakistan Carpet manufacturers and exporters association, Local consumption of these carpets are very less and around 99% of the carpets made here are for export.

TYPES OF CARPETS EXPORTED BY PAKISTAN:

Three types of hand-knotted carpets are produced and/ or marketed by Pakistan –

1. Single knot (major qualities are Bokhara, Jaldar and Silk Touch)
2. Double knot (popularly known as Pak-Persion Carpets)
3. Turkish Knot made with hand spun vegetable dyes learned and indigenized from Afghan refugees settled in Pakistan (major qualities include Ziegler or Chobi, Kazak, Karghai, Khal Mohammadi, & Modern Gabbeh).
