

Belize is a democratic, upper middle-income country located at the Caribbean coast of Central America. A member of both the Caribbean forum (CARIFORUM) and the Central American Integration System, Belize connects Central America and the Caribbean. The area of the country totals 22,960 square kilometers (8,865 sq mi). The major trading partners of Belize are the United States, Mexico, the United Kingdom, the European Union, and CARICOM.

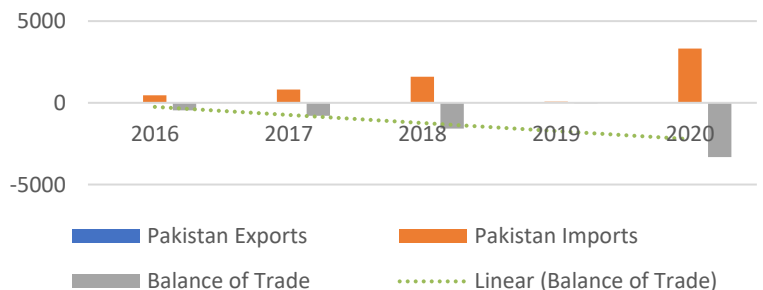

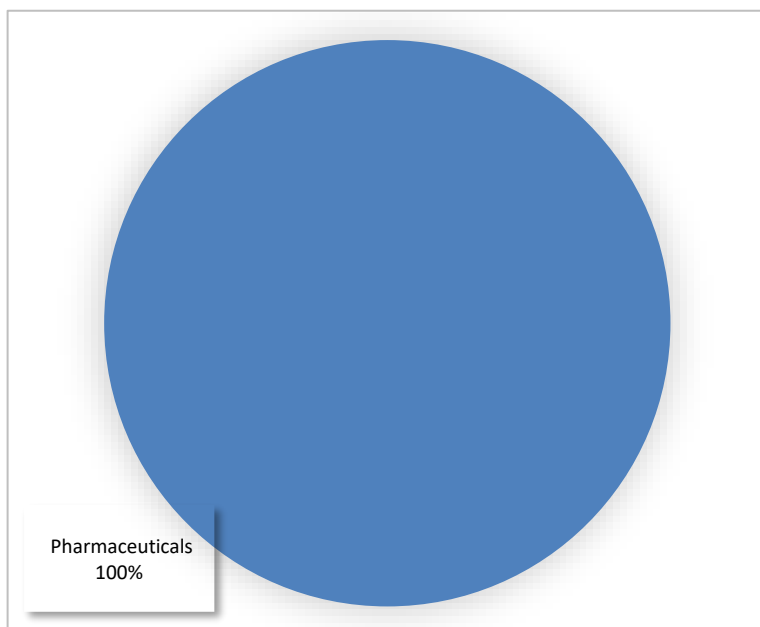
