

Pakistan – Cote D' Ivoire Trade Relationship



The importance of Pakistan-Cote D'Ivoire relations can be determined by the establishment of new diplomatic mission in Cote D'Ivoire by Islamabad under Look Africa Policy to strengthen Afro-Pak trade and diplomatic ties. Although the numbers of trade between the two countries are not impressive, but there is a huge untapped potential.

Pakistan's exports to Cote d'Ivoire mainly include rice, apparel & clothing and cereals etc. Imports of Pakistan from Cote d'Ivoire mainly include raw cotton, wood and Industrial fatty acids. Pakistan's export to Cote d'Ivoire was US\$ 33.502 million during 2020, whereas the Import was US\$ 74.378 million during 2020.

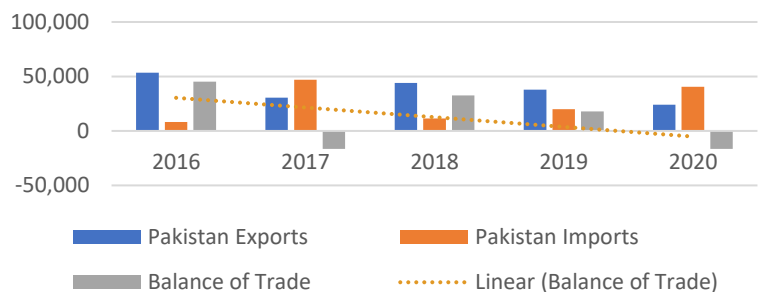

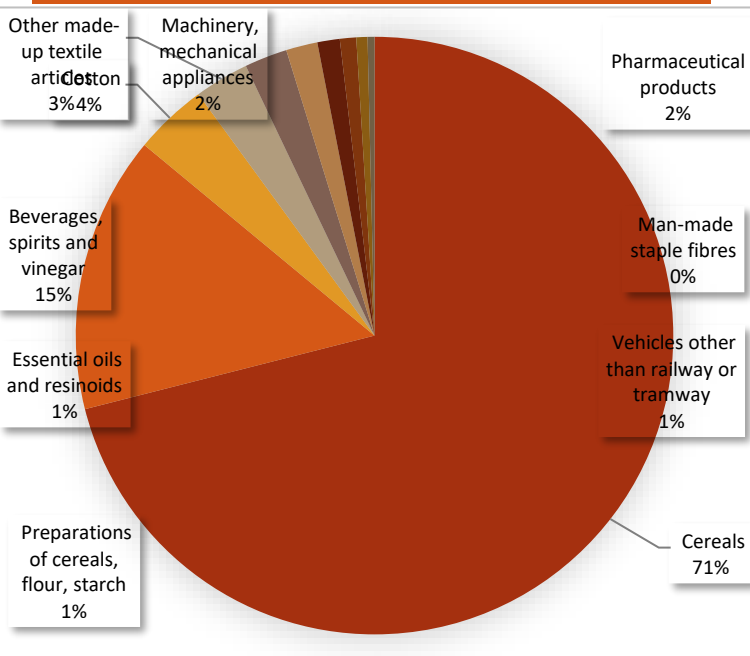
