The Democratic Republic of Congo is the largest country of Central Africa in terms of size. The country is rich of natural resources such as diamonds, copper, gold and oil, which it exports in large quantities. The country also produces wood products and coffee for exportation towards its main partners such as China, Zambia and Belgium.

However, despite its large potential, Congo DRC is classified as the least developed country according to UNDP's Human Development Index partly due to a long period of political instability. Pakistan's Export to D. R. Congo was US\$ 16.89 million during 2020 and Import was US\$ 3.74 million.


