

Gabon is an upper-middle-income country. The fifth largest oil producer in Africa, it has had strong economic growth over the past decade, driven by its production of oil and manganese. The oil sector has accounted for 80% of exports and 45% of GDP. However, as the country is facing a decline in its oil reserves, the Gabonese government has decided to diversify its economy. Pakistan Exports to Gabon was US\$639.17 Thousand during 2020 and Imports from Gabon of Miscellaneous chemical products was US\$286 during 2020.

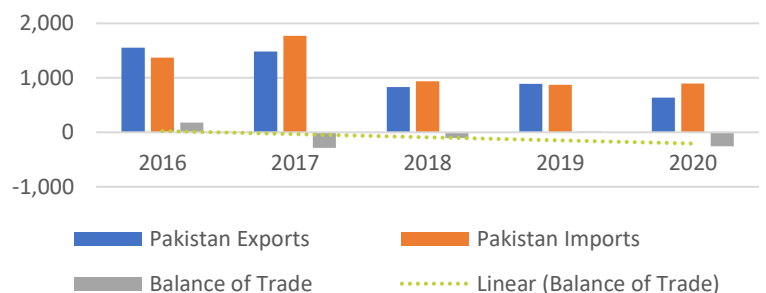

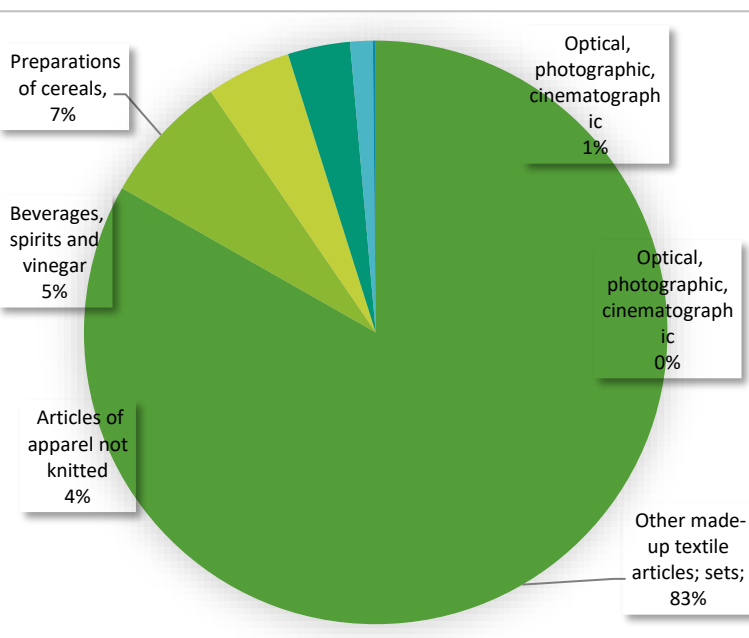
