

Pakistan - Mexico Trade Relationship





Mexico is a business-friendly country with enormous trade potential. It imports amounted to \$383.3 bn. Pakistan's exports to Mexico accounts to \$66 Mn, ranking Pakistan as the 58^{th} largest trading partner of the country.

The export value registered a significant decrease from \$101,17 million in 2016 to mere \$66 Billion in 2020. On the contrary, the import has surged in term of value and reported a considerable increase from \$41.4 million in 2016 to \$114.13 million in 2020 recording a huge trade deficit of \$48.10 favoring Mexico.


