Pakistan – Tunisia Trade Relationship





Tunisia has significant importance due to its geographical location. On the one hand, it is connected to the developed European countries and on the other it is at the crossroads of emerging African markets, which can create opportunities for Pakistan's economy and trade. Moreover, there are bright prospects of a preferential trade agreement (PTA) between Pakistan and Tunisia and such a deal can potentially expand bilateral trade between the two countries.

the two countries is likely to double after the preferential trade agreement comes into
effect. According to the United Nations' database on international trade, Pakistan's exports
to Tunisia amounted to \$13.41 million during 2020. On the other hand, Pakistan's imports
from Tunisia stood at \$17.52 million during the year.




