

Uruguay, officially the Oriental Republic of Uruguay is located on the South Atlantic Ocean coast of southern South America, south of Brazil. It borders Argentina in west. With an area of 176,000 km², the country is the second-smallest nation (after Suriname) in South America.

Major agricultural products are cotton, sugarcane, soybeans, corn, wheat, tobacco, cassava (manioc, tapioca), fruits, vegetables, beef, pork, eggs, milk and timber. Major industries are sugar processing, cement, textiles, beverages, wood products, steel, base metals, and electric power.

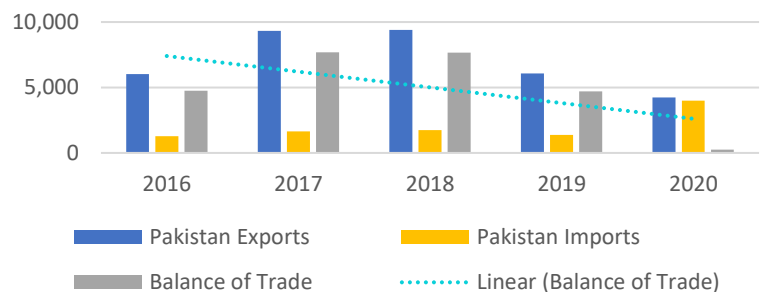

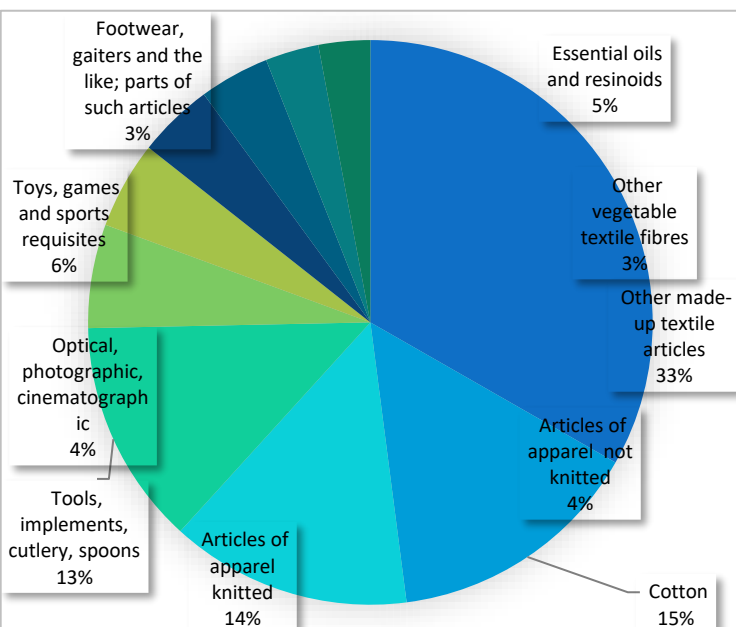
