# Pakistan – Zimbabwe Trade Relationship





Zimbabwe and Pakistan are working on enhancing trade and cooperation beyond the last joint cooperation between the two countries which was signed in 1995. The two countries are not fully exploiting trade opportunities that exist for both after the signing of a joint cooperation memorandum 27 years ago, as trade between the two countries is limited to just a few products.

The products from Pakistan include rice and tractors whereas from Zimbabwe they are vegetables and oil, which requires further diversification. Pakistan's Export to Zimbabwe was US\$ 11.92 million during 2020 and there were no Imports in 2020.


