To create a dedicated, effective and empowered organization for development and promotion of exports;

To establish greater clarity of institutional arrangements for purposes of policy formulation relating to trade; and development of trade initiatives and implementation thereof amongst the Ministry of Commerce, trade development organizations; and the private sector.




Powers & Functions of the Board

Section 20, TDAP Act 2013: Powers and the functions of the Board:

Supreme decision making body of the Authority - Power to supervise, control, direct and regulate affairs of the Authority and shall have following <u>Functions</u>:

- (a) Establish critical success factors and KPIs for the Authority
- (b) Annual Performance Review
- (c) Policy advise to the Federal Government
- (d) Approval of Rules and Regulations proposed by the Authority
- (e) Approval of the annual budget and expenditure
- (f) Give opinion on any policy matter referred to it by the Federal Government
- (g) Exercise all powers and perform functions assigned under the Act



- All policy decisions, including any change in the previously established policies, in respect of all and any matters within the jurisdiction of the Authority shall be made only by the Board.
- 2. The Board may also adopt policy recommendations of the Authority with or without modifications as the Board may deem fit in its sole discretion

The Board shall have the authority to delegate any of its powers to the Chief Executive

The Authority shall be the Secretariat of the Board

TDAP Management

Chief Executive

- Appointed by Federal Govt. for 3 yrs (extendable)
- Principal Accounting Officer
- Responsible for managing all affairs of TDAP and achieving objectives (together with Secretary, DGs & any officer nominated by Board)
- Reports to TDAP Board





Reorganization of TDAP




- TDAP reorganized its functioning on sectoral lines to provide specialized facilitation to all stakeholders.



Finances of TDAP




Pakistan Africa Trade Development Conference-PATDC (30-31, January 2020)

- Under the "Look Africa Policy initiative", MOC in collaboration with TDAP organized the PATDC in Nairobi, Kenya, from 30-31 January 2020, which is first of its kind

- 10% increase in exports were registered during July-April 2020



Remodeling and Expansion of KEC Project Details

- Expansion and Remodelling of Karachi Expo Centre with
 - 9 Halls ,A Convention Centre, A Multi Storeyed parking plaza, TDAP Offices/IT Tower.
- Contract was awarded to M/S NESPAK for Remodelling / Master Planning, Architectural and Engineering Design and Construction Supervision of KEC in May 2018.
- Original PC-I for 9 halls, convention center and IT Tower was Rs. 11 billion

TDAP initiatives during COVID-19

- TDAP is organizing Webinars (19 training sessions for different cities) through Zoom online meeting. A webinar for the exporters of Sialkot is organized on 22nd July 2020.
- Six Seminars of CPFTAs were organized in different cities. However, Planned Seminars on CPFTA-II suspended. Webinar is introduced for dissemination of information on CPFTA-II
- All manual COOs are to be digitized and issued online after necessary designing, amendment/reengineering. The work is in progress.
- GSP section remained opened during Lockdown to facilitate Trade. COOs (GSP, FTAs, PTAs) were issued on regular basis. In wake of Lockdown, few countries viz., Malaysia, Indonesia, Mauritius & Oman temporarily suspended the manual issuance of COOs and informed that they will issue online COOs to their Exporters. (1533 certificates issued)

VIRTUAL EXHIBITION AND MARKETPLACE

- TDAP is organizing Virtual exhibitions to market the Pakistani products internationally as the exhibitors are unable to participate in international exhibitions due to cancellations.
- Virtual exhibition of Textile, leather, Sports goods, Agro food, Surgical and Services sector are being organized
- B2B Match making platform is also being developed to have permanent presence of Pakistani products

Impact of Covid-19 on Expo Centre Karachi

- Expo Centre is handed over to Sindh Government and Pakistan Army in the month of March 2020 in order to convert into an Isolation Centre for Corona patients
- A total of 56 exhibitions were cancelled (March to Oct 2020) due to COVID-19 and anticipated with revenue loss of around Rs. 200 million



PAKISTAN'S EXPORTS OVER THE YEARS





Pakistan's Export during July - June 2019-20




Pakistan's Top Export Destinations showing decrease during July- June 2019-20





Pakistan's Top Export Destinations showing increase during July - June 2019-20



Pakistan's Top Export Sectors – July-June 2019-2020




PAKISTAN'S IMPORTS OVER THE YEARS


Pakistan's Import during July - June 2019-20






