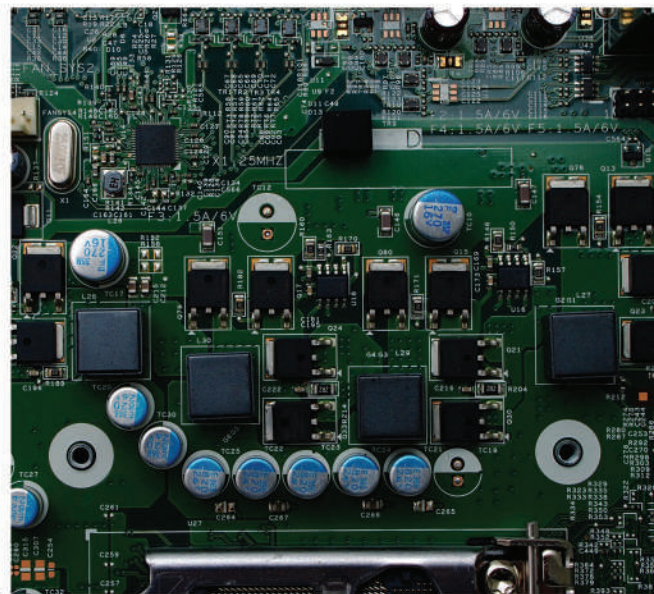

PAKISTAN'S INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INDUSTRY

A.T Kearny has ranked Pakistan amongst the top fifty economies of the Global Services Location Index (GSLI) to relocate IT and BPO processes since 2009 and declared it the most cost-effective location in the world in 2017. Over 6,000 Pakistan based IT companies are providing IT products and services to entities in over 100 countries.

More than 7,000 tech companies are generating a revenue of 3 billion USD and going to cross 5 billion USD mark soon. It has attracted more than 100 foreign investment deals in the last four years which reflects the level of confidence of international tech giants in Pakistan's IT potential.

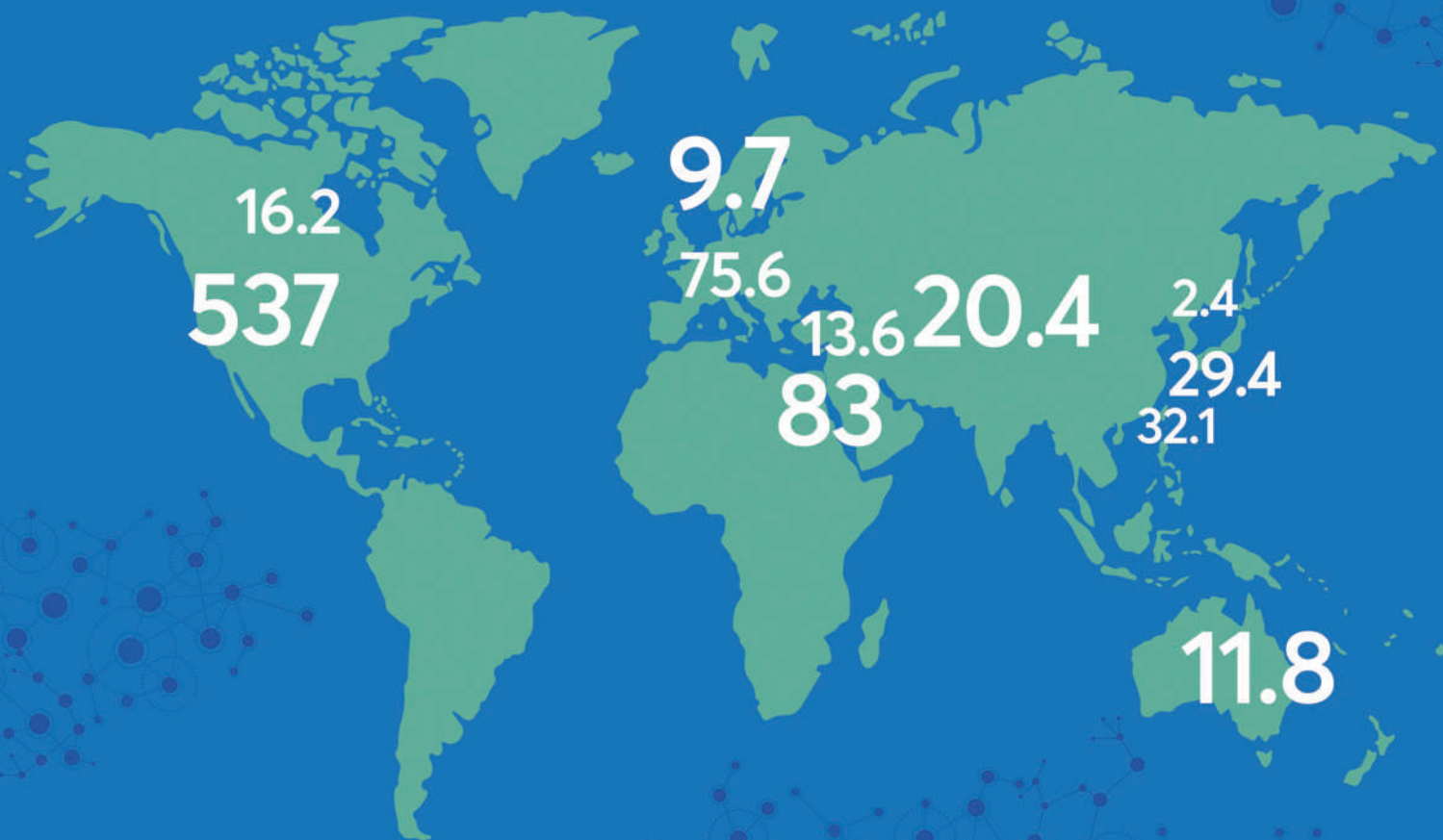
